

VOTING IS EASY!

Who?

In New York you can register to vote if you are 18, or pre-register if you are 16 or 17.

You can only VOTE if you are 18 or older on election day.

Where?

You can register online at the NYS DMV: <https://dmv.ny.gov/>
OR

Print out a Voter Registration form from NYSBOE: <https://www.elections.ny.gov/> and mail it to your county Board of Elections.

What?

To register you will need:

- NY State DMV driver license, permit or Non-Driver ID
- Current ZIP code
- Last 4 digits of SSN

When?

To be updated on election dates and issues:

Text VOTENY to 474747 (League of Women Voters NYS service)

OR

Go to www.VOTE411.org (League of Women Voters NYS information site)

Why?

Only 2/3 of eligible voters turned out in the 2020 election.

Some Presidential elections are decided by 30% of the population.

The lowest turnout is the youth vote, age 18-29.

Huh?
